## **Executive Biography**

Scott retired from the USDA in November 2021, as Disaster Response Coordinator in the FNS Office of Emergency Management, having worked closely with FEMA and other Federal agencies on the COVID-19 disaster response and other disasters, including wildfires, rolling blackouts, floods, and hurricanes.

Scott has worked on a range of high-profile national issues, from working with congress on the Hurricane Katrina investigation, to local issues, like finding opportunities for community gardens, farmers markets, and regional food systems to support access to nutritious food for low-income communities. His extensive network of partners is critical to ensuring solutions and opportunities are provided to Conduit clients.

Scott earned his Bachelor of Arts in Journalism/Public Relations from California State University -Fresno in 1993. He is a proud veteran of the United States Air Force, where he met his fellow veteran and wife, Stephanie.
